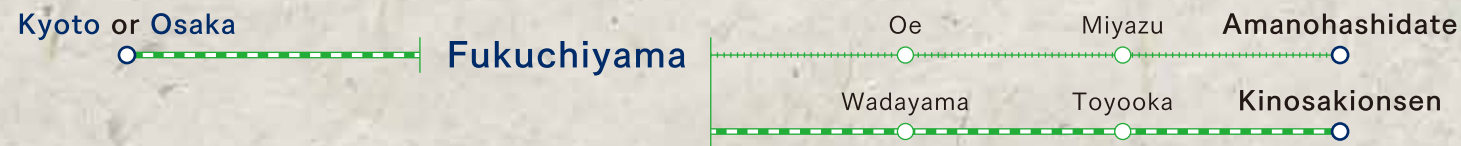


Getting to FUKUCHIYAMA

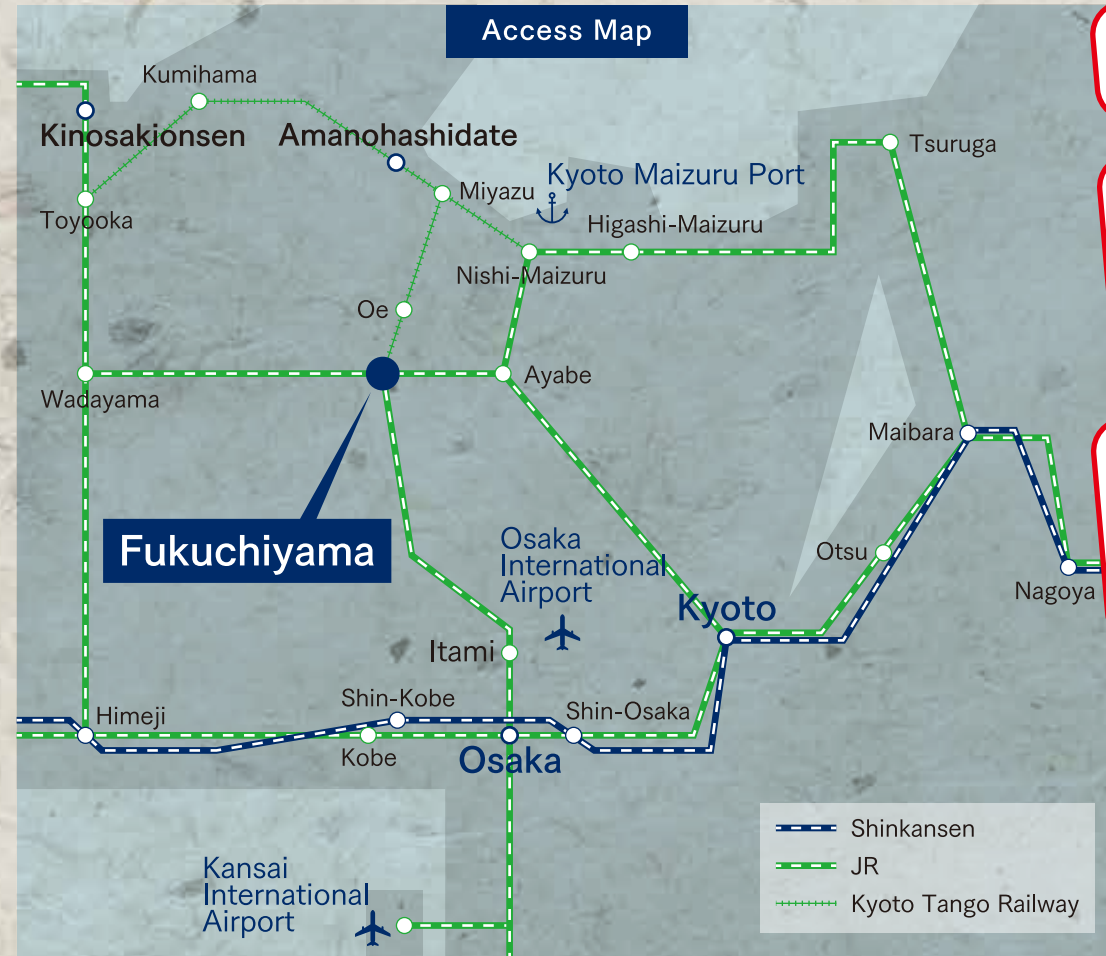
Fukuchiyama is easy to access from anywhere in Kansai.

Access Map



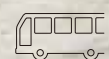
1 hour from

1 hour 30 min
from Osaka Station

Take the JR Fukuchiyama
Line (Express train) and
get off at Fukuchiyama Sta.



By Highway Bus

Nonstop

From Osaka approx. 1 hour 50 min.
From Kobe approx. 1 hour 30 min.
From Tokyo approx. 9 hours 30 min.

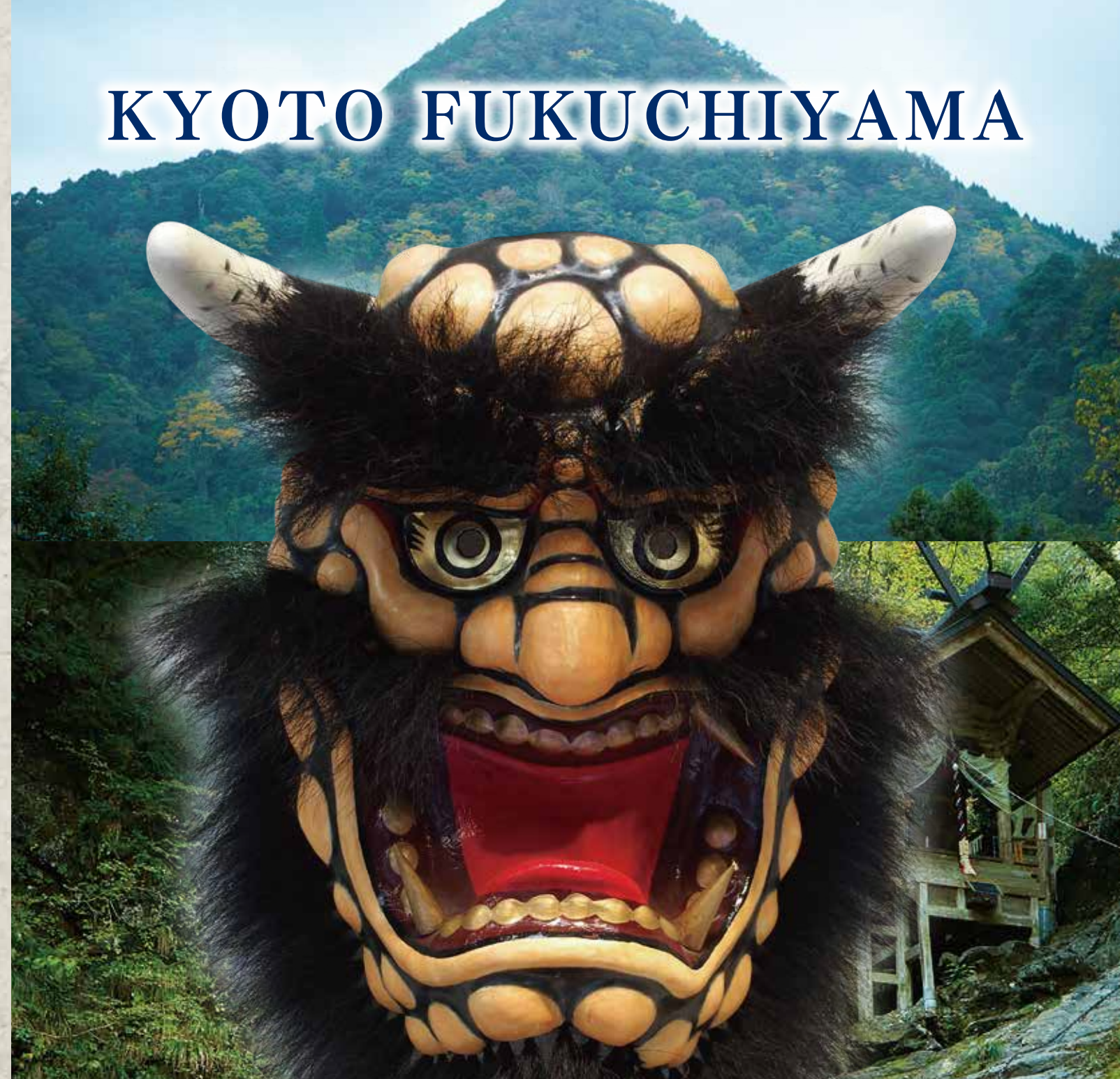

Mt.Oe is also home to the Shinto goddess of the sun.

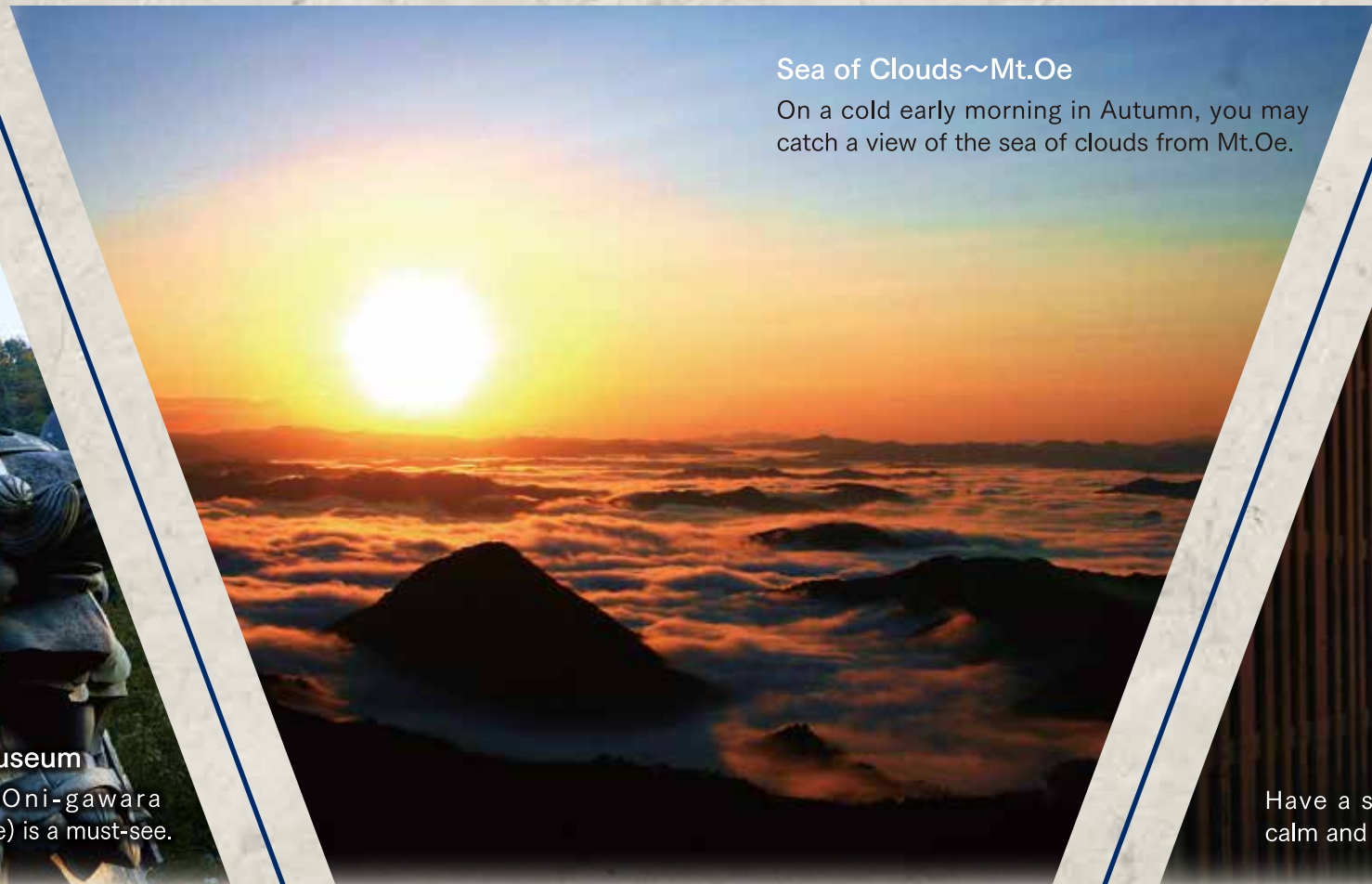


Motoise (Originally Ise) Naiku Kotai-jinja Shrine

Sea of Clouds~Mt.Oe

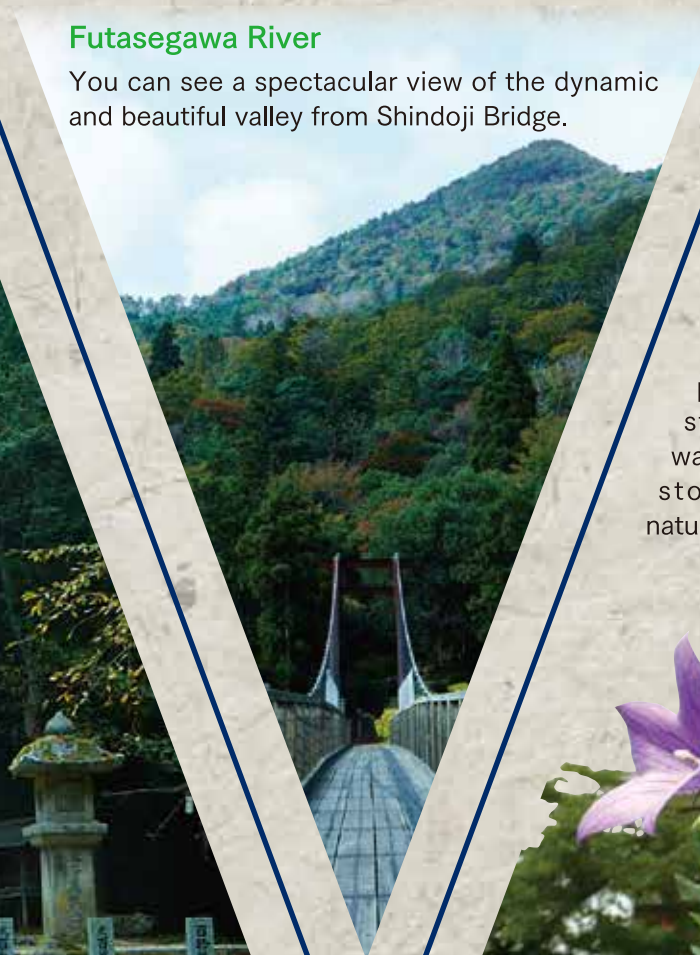
On a cold early morning in Autumn, you may catch a view of the sea of clouds from Mt.Oe.

You can see a spectacular view of the dynamic and beautiful valley from Shindoji Bridge.



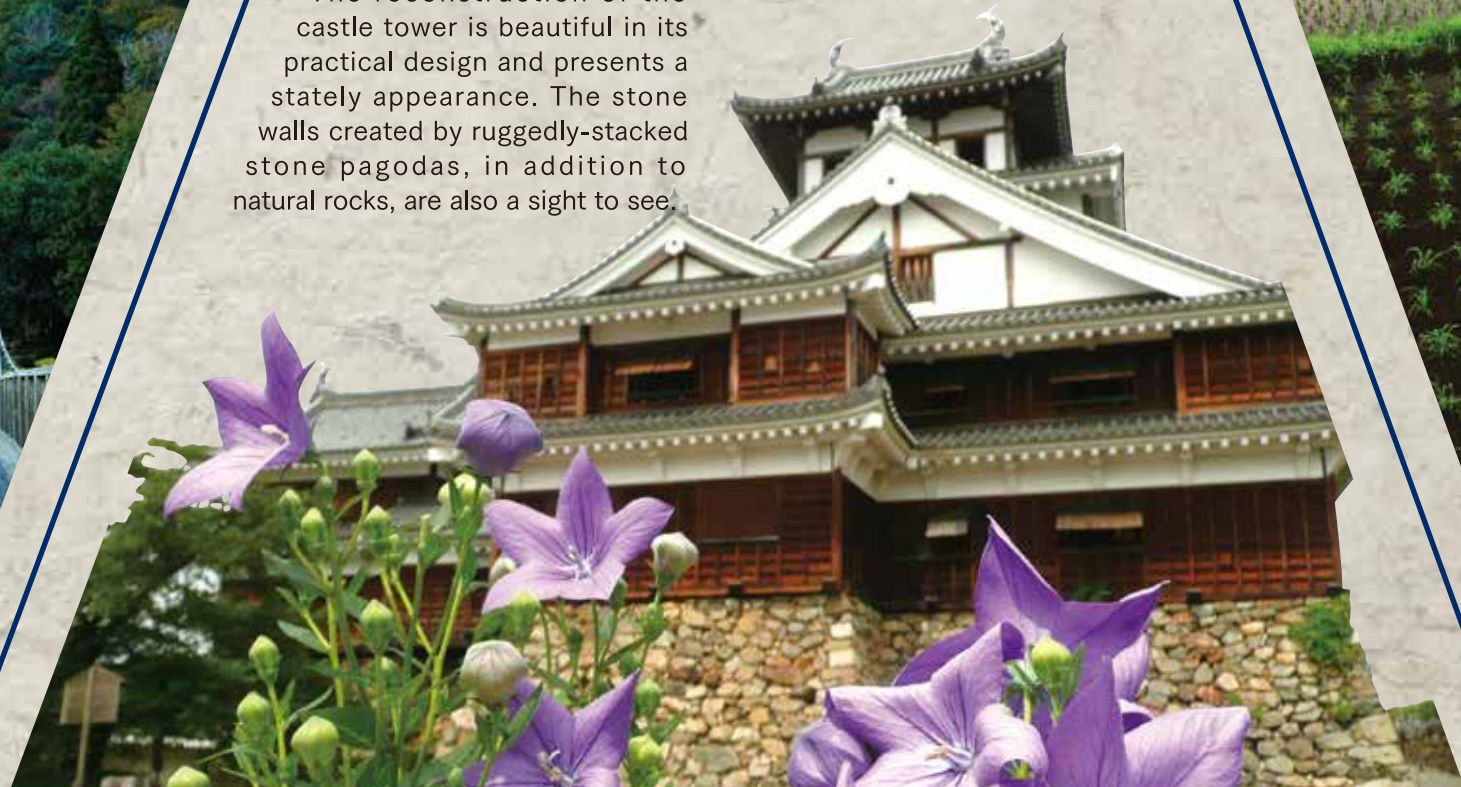
Have a stroll in a historic, calm and quiet castle town.

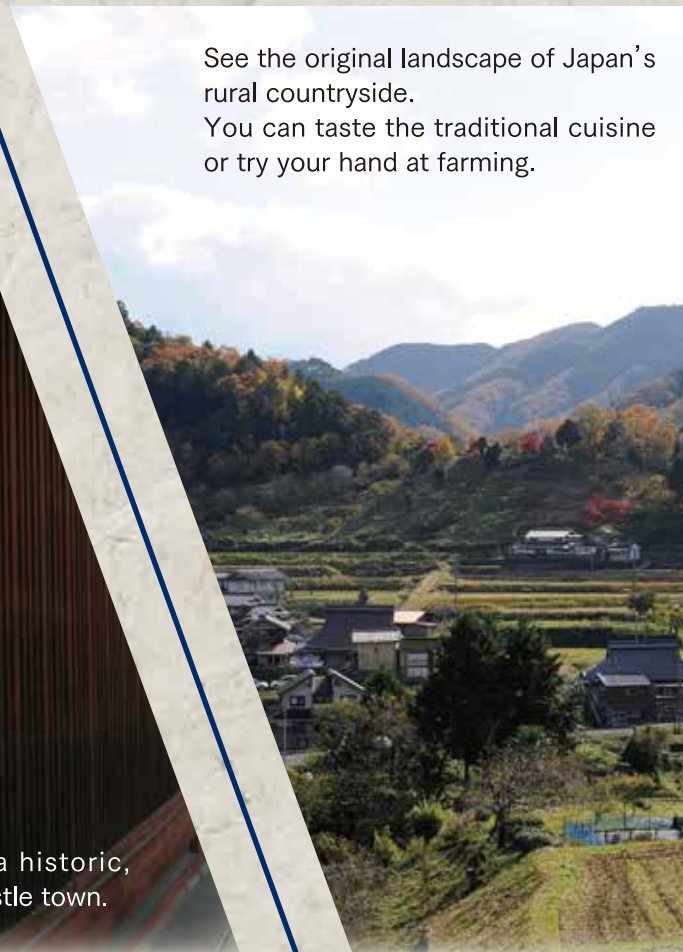


Fukuchiyama Castle
